

Agreement

Establishing the Nobility International Security Institute

June 15, 2020

The Contracting Parties,
Desiring to strengthen the United Nations,
Desiring to secure the Nation of Aristopolis,
Desiring to promote international security and interests,
Agree as follows:

Article 1

Establishment of the Agency

The Nobility International Security Institute is hereby established.

Article 2

Definitions

For the purposes of this Agreement:

- 2.1 “NI” shall mean the Nobility International;
- 2.2 “Agency” shall mean the Nobility International Security Institute (NISI);
- 2.3 “Member” shall mean a party to the present Agreement.
- 2.4 “Director General” shall mean a person selected by the NI as its representative;
- 2.5 “UN” shall mean the United Nations;

Article 3

Objectives of the Agency

The objectives of the Agency are:

- 3.1 to educate decision-makers in military and civilian roles on global defence and strategic interests;
- 3.2 to highlight the importance of Western civilization and the reversal of its decline;
- 3.3 to inform the public of geopolitical situations pertaining to the UN, the international community, and the Nation of Aristopolis;

Article 4
Functions

In order to attain the objectives described in Article 3, the Agency:

- 4.1 shall perform research about events, situations, and issues pertaining to international security;
- 4.2 shall analyze findings, consult with experts, and explore solutions;
- 4.3 shall publish information on vital UN defence, strategic and international security issues;

Article 5
Membership

5.1 Membership in the Agency shall be exclusively open to members of the NI and any other Families invited by the Administration to become a party to this Agreement.

5.2 Families may become party to this Agreement and Member of the Agency

Article 6
Administration

6.1 There shall be an Administration consisting of Parties selected by the NI.

6.2 The Administration shall be directed by a Director General.

6.3 The Administration shall implement appropriate policies required for the execution of the Agency's Functions.

6.4 Each Family shall be represented by one representative, who may be assisted by alternate representatives, advisors, and experts.

Article 7
Finances

The Agency's expenses shall be evenly borne by the Contracting Parties.

Article 8
Entry into Force of the Agreement

The present Agreement shall enter into force upon compliance with Article 33 of the NI charter.

Article 9
Withdrawal

9.1 Any Member Family may withdraw from this Agreement by notification to the Director General.

9.2 Withdrawal shall take effect three months after receipt of the notification.
